

### **<b>OManyo Line "Cycle Tram"**

Enjoy cycling more, using the Cycle Train and the ferry!

A Cycle Tram operates from April 1 to November 30 and cyclists must make a reservation two days in advance. **Yellowtail** (Best season: October - February) Yellowtail caught in Toyama Bay become firm and plump in the cold sea currents, and are the prized catch of Toyama Bay. 


