What Is a Night Junior High School?

A Night School is a school where people who, for various reasons, were unable to complete their compulsory education can "return to school" to continue their studies.

(Night Junior High School)

This school responds to the positive desire of students who say,
“I want to start learning now.”

Night Junior High School is open to individuals who have passed school-age
(from the day they turn age 15 until the following 31st March) and who:

Have not completed compulsory education for various reasons

Were unable to fully complete compulsory education due to reasons
such as refusal to attend school

Are foreign nationals who have not completed compulsory education
in their home country or in Japan

Curriculum

- The curriculum includes nine academic subjects, as well as a special subject in morality, special activities, and integrated learning periods.
- Classes are taught by licensed teachers.
- If necessary, students can receive Japanese language instruction.
- Students can also review materials covered in elementary school.
- Students cannot selectively enroll in specific academic subjects or Japanese language instruction.
- Upon graduation, students will receive a junior high school diploma.



School Life

- Classes are held on weekdays (Monday~Friday) from 5:40 P.M. to 8:50 P.M.
- There are four classes per day.
- Each class lasts 40 minutes.
- There are summer and winter breaks.
- There are breaks (for meals).
- Students who need meals must prepare their own.

* Japanese language instruction may be provided during class for students who need it.



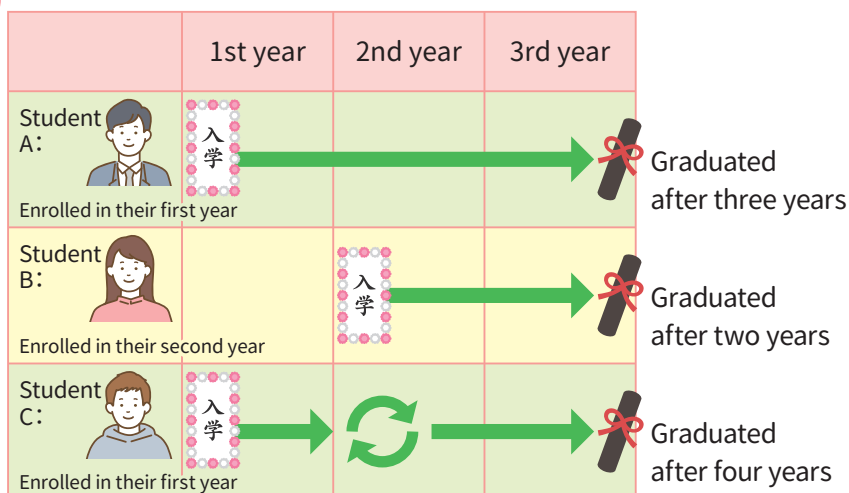
Expenses

- There are no tuition or textbook fees.

- You may also need to pay for event participation fees and transportation costs.



Duration of Study

- The program begins in a student's first year, from which they will study for three years.
- Students may enroll during their second or third year of school.
- The maximum duration of study is six years.

Location and Directions

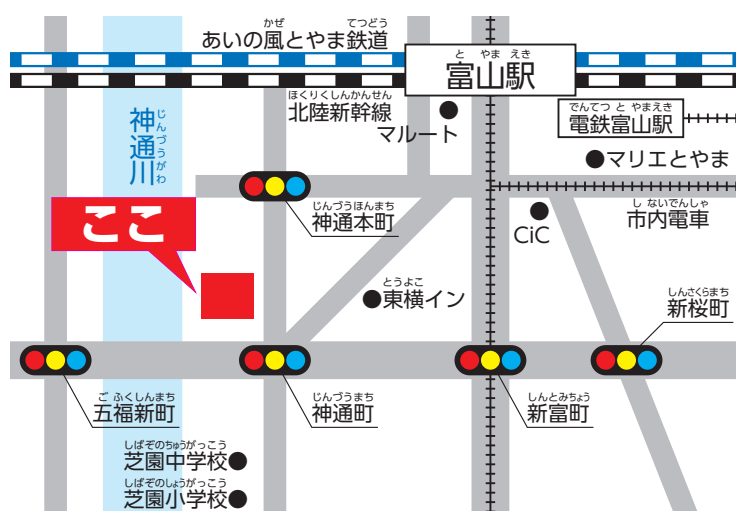
